


ZENITH HEALTH CARE NETWORK MEDICAL PROVIDER SEARCH INSTRUCTIONS

Your employer is participating in the Zenith Health Care Network (also known as ZHCN). Zenith provides access to their website to obtain a listing of industrial clinics and/or physicians within their network.

You may select an initial treating doctor of your choice from the network for treatment and follow up care. Once you select a provider, contact your adjuster with the medical provider's information.

Option 1

The provider directory is available at <https://www.thezenith.com/atlas/>.


1. Go to the “**I am a...**” box and select from one of the options: **Injured Employee, Employer or a Medical Provider**. Please select **Employer**.
2. Another box will appear, asking **what you are searching for**. Please select **Medical Provider**
3. Another box will appear, asking you to select a state. Please select Texas. Then click **Enter**
4. You will automatically be directed to the **Provider Search tab**.
5. Go to **Search by Provider** and under **Provider Types** select Treating Doctor.
6. Go to **Search by Location** and enter the employer or injured employee's home address.
7. Go to **Search Distance (miles)** and select the search distance.
8. Click **Search**.
9. To print a listing, select **Create Directory – Other as Claim Administrator**, then select **Create Directory** and .
